EXPLODED ON MILES!

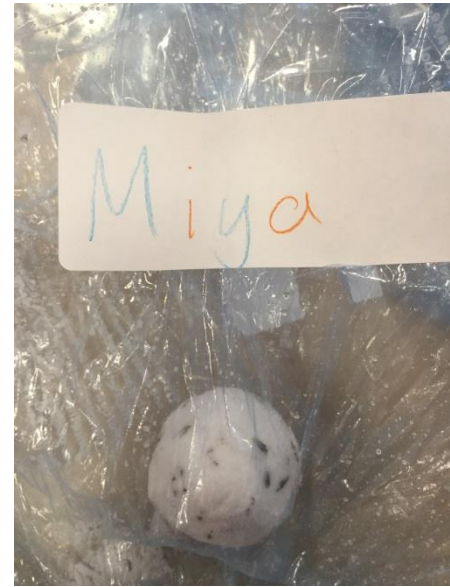
