- 4. Logging in within the app


Finding Puffin Academy in the App Store (Apple) and Google play Store (Android)



First of all, you will need to go to your App Store, which can usually be found on your device's Home Screen.



Click into it, then search for Puffin Academy using the search function at the top right.



Once within the Puffin Browser app, you will need to search for EducationCity by using the Search function. Enter 'EducationCity' at the top right and the search results will appear towards the bottom of the page.


