We will ensure that our approaches to teaching and learning meet the needs of our pupils. We will use assessment and analysis of data to address the learning needs of our pupils post lockdown.

We will continue to develop staff skills in assessment and moderation and work with cluster colleagues to ensure our judgements on attainment are accurate and robust.



ICT will remain a focus so that learning is accessible using digital solutions - for home learning and/or blended learning. All staff will move to digital planning tools so that pupils' progress can continue in any situation where remote or distant learning is required.

We will audit and coordinate staff professional learning to develop our digital skills further. We will support pupils and families using SeeSaw (Nursery Class), Google Classroom, Google Meets and Microsoft Teams.

Communication with our families will continue using Google Meets for Parents' Evenings to ensure sharing pupils' achievements remains a priority; video content for virtual events such as Curriculum Evening and Assemblies, so that the annual calendar of events can be continued; and updates posted on Twitter and Class Blogs to celebrate achievements.

Staff, pupils and families will self-evaluate against the Rights Respecting Schools Gold criteria and the Gold Family Friendly Approaches criteria to ensure we are meeting the needs of our school community during this period of Learning Recovery.



Nurturing approaches will continue to be refreshed and embedded to meet the pastoral and emotional needs of our pupils, parents and staff.

Emotion Works will be introduced throughout the school and a refreshed implementation of Bounce Back will support pupil resilience and school recovery.
