#### BSKC Eastwood Karting

The Eastwood karting team of Stuart King, Iain McIntosh and Alan Regan, took part in the Scottish regional final of the British Schools Karting Championship (BSKC) at Knockhill Racing Circuit on 16th April. Although Eastwood didn't make it through to the National finals 'down south', we finished a very respectable 6th out of 15 teams. Although the boys had no experience of racing in extremely wet conditions with slick tyres, they excelled themselves when the track eventually dried - Ian McIntosh finished in 4th position, Stuart King started 11th and finished 2nd and Alan Regan started 7th, dropped to 9th then worked his way through the field to come in 1st - outstanding results all round. We will hold trials next session for pupils who are interested in taking part in the BSK Championship next year where we look forward to building on our success.

#### Fairtrade Fortnight activity

During Fair Trade fortnight the Human Rights' Group held a "how many nuts in the jar" competition. Nicola Connor, S5 won a Fair Trade Easter egg by guessing

the number closest to 718. With the money raised we have sent a cheque for £70 to Traidcraft. Thanks also to the generosity of the staff we raised £120 from their donations when they signed our big Christmas card. With that money we have twinned our toilets at EHS with two toilets in BeongRaithbong Village Cambodia (the Group's choice). Toilet twinning is a partnership between Cord and Tearfund, two international charities who work together because 2.6 billion people in the world do not have access to somewhere safe and hygienic to go to the loo.
