#### Super Students

Congratulations to all our pupils who sat SQA exams in May this year. Eastwood High had its best ever set of results at both Intermediate 2 and Higher. The S4 (Now S5) worked incredibly hard and had their diligence rewarded beating the previous record for pupils gaining 5 or more Intermediate 2 passes by 6% (66% means that two thirds of 54 last year passed five or more exams at Intermediate 2). Records were also broken at Intermediate 1 in S4 and Higher in S5. The challenge now is for everyone to work hard from day one this session to convert 2013's excellent results into even better next year.

In addition to superb performances across the board, special mention should go to the following pupils who excelled gaining either 10 Intermediate 2 As in S4 or 5 Higher As in S5—a record number for the school.
