



Muffin Box Information Sheet

Situation

In the near future you will be making mini muffins in Home Economics and you will require a packaging box to take a few of them home to share. Packaging is important as it is used to protect the items enclosed for safe transportation, ease of stacking or shelving. It is also used to advertise the item and attract attention.

Design and create a box that will allow you to do this. You will have a choice of two layouts/developments:

1. Transparent lid box
2. Card split lid box

The specification below outlines all the information that has to be included on the packaging that is suitable for food.

Specification

The final design of the muffin box must include:

- your name;
- a logo;
- contact details including a website;
- the complaints procedure;
- a barcode;
- a rectangular box/space for the ingredients;
- a best before date;
- nutritional information
- the NET weight **e** 250g;
- recyclable logo;
- don't litter/keep Britain tidy logo;
- the directions on how to store;
- a serving suggestion.

Here are a few examples of muffin boxes you may find in the supermarket.
