## **Parent Interviews - Online Appointment Booking**

## Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March

I would like to invite you to attend our Parent Interviews on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> or Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March. The interview is designed to give you an opportunity to meet your child's class teacher, review and discuss their progress this term and read over some of their class work.
