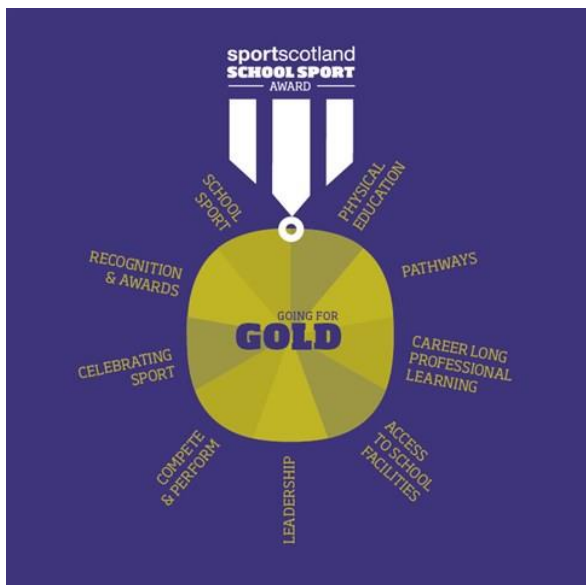

Giffnock Primary School has just received a gold school sports award from SportsScotland. There are nine areas which the award considers.

What is the School Sport Award?

The SportsScotland School Sport Award is a national Lottery funded initiative designed to encourage schools to continuously improve physical education (PE) and school sport opportunities. The SportsScotland School Sport Award:

- Encourages schools to self-reflect and continuously improve
- Puts young people at the forefront of the decision making and planning of PE and sport in their school
- Helps schools to increase young people's opportunities and engagement in PE & school sport
- Helps schools to put PE & school sport at the heart of their planning, practice and ethos
- Recognises and celebrates successful PE & school sport models



In April 2015, the school submitted an application for a sports award. The school was awarded with a silver medal. Subsequently, a Sports Committee was formed consisting of members from each stage in the school. The committee makes decisions related to sport and physical education in the school. We also work closely with neighbouring schools and the Active Schools Co-ordinators to help to provide a very wide range of sporting opportunities for children at Giffnock Primary School.
