APFS (Arts Projects for Schools), the company who print the Christmas Cards have contacted the Parent Council to say that their new online ordering system has been unable to cope with demand and that they are reverting to the traditional ordering system.

We asked for artwork to be returned by Thursday 10th November but please hold off on sending it back into the school until the new order forms have been sent home in the school bags. We are awaiting receipt of these.

The new order forms will allow you to indicate how many packs of cards/gift tags/wrapping paper you wish to order. As in previous years, please attach this to your child's design along with payment. The company have also asked that you attach the existing online form too. I think this is so they can match up any online orders which may have already been processed. If you were able to order online, I think it would be wise to indicate this on your paper order form.

The cards do not raise a lot of money for school funds but the Parent Council have continued to do them because we know many children and their families love having personalised cards to send at Christmas. This confusion is far from ideal but we don't want to disappoint children who have already designed their cards and neither do the company so we will continue to organise and review for next year.
