Promoting enjoying books!	Recommend books for readers across the school on the website and via Twitter.	Think about your favourite books for all different stages and write a small book review. <i>(Get previous Librarians involved?)</i>
Jamboree	Meet with last year's librarians to make a task for writing.	Arrange a time to meet with the P6s.
Other ideas		Think about anything else you would like the librarians to consider doing.
