Time: **4.15pm-5.45pm**
Cost: **£45.00** (This covers instructor fees, and ski equipment hire (Skis and boots) which the centre will provide on arrival).

Please note that there will be **no transport** provided therefore you must make appropriate arrangements for your child to be transported to and from the venue.

Clothing: Children should wear comfortable clothing to the lessons, suitable for outdoor weather and it essential that pupils provide their own GLOVES.

Payment & pupil details will be taken at the time of booking. Pupils will be allocated to the session which best suits their ability as noted in the level descriptor below.

Level Descriptor:

Beginner: New to the sport, or one-two hours experience.

Intermediate: Can link snowplough turns to control speed from the top of the small slope.

Advanced/Intermediate: Can ski with confidence on the main slope, allowing skis to become parallel between turns.

Advanced: Able to link parallel turns on the main slope.

Please note that spaces are limited due to the nature of this sport so please book early via the contact number provided to avoid disappointment.
