Article 29:

What is the School Sport Award?

The SportsScotland School Sport Award is a national Lottery funded initiative designed to encourage schools to continuously improve physical education (PE) and school sport opportunities. The SportsScotland School Sport Award:

- Encourages schools to self-reflect and continuously improve
- Puts young people at the forefront of the decision making and planning of PE and sport in their school
- Helps schools to increase young people's opportunities and engagement in PE & school sport
- Helps schools to put PE & school sport at the heart of their planning, practice and ethos
- Recognises and celebrates successful PE & school sport models



What do we do?

Our Sports Committee is made up of elected class representatives from Primary 1 to 7. They help to support and promote sport and healthy life styles for all of our children, in a range of different ways.

Our Sports Committee have been heavily involved in co-ordinating all of the work and development involved in attaining our Gold Award.

We have also helped to design and implement a Health & Wellbeing Passport for many of our children, through which many of our children are tracking their own fitness and development.

We also help with the selection of sports resources for the school over the last three sessions, including for break times.

An important part of our role is also to help promote the range of extra-curricular clubs and opportunities that happen each term.
