It's French Friday again already!

Today Camembear and Lapinou are going to teach us a little finger rhyme which some of you may already know. It's about two little birds sitting on a branch. They tell us their names in French. They say hello and goodbye to us. Watch the video on Twitter and join in if you can.

Camembear and Lapinou wanted to act out the finger rhyme so we made little birds out of recycled card. They used a stick as a branch.

You can draw two little birds and cut them out. You will need a strip of card too to make into a ring for your finger to go in. Stick the cardboard ring onto the back of your bird and you'll have a finger puppet.



There are two videos to watch. One is with little bird puppets and one is just using your fingers (like we do at nursery). You can decide how you want to do it.
