When no more seeds are left on the dandelion you have reached the right dandelion time! My clock took 3 blows so it's 3 o'clock.

There's a well known song about a clock that you can sing together and do the actions:

*Hickory, Dickory, Dock.  
The mouse ran up the clock  
The clock struck one, the mouse ran down  
Hickory, Dickory, Dock.  
Tick, tock, tick, tock, tick, tock, tick, tock.  
Repeat: Two, the mouse went "Boo!"  
Three, the mouse went, "Weeee"  
Four, The mouse said, "no more"  
Five, The mouse said, "Bye"*

Clap the right number each time and hold up the correct number of fingers for each number.
