We are going to do a little number exploration today. You might want to get an adult to draw the outline of your favourite number or your age and then you can make the shape of it. I used stones from the garden but you could use anything you have lying around, maybe bottle tops from the recycling?

Can you spot your age in the numbers I made?



Because it had been raining I found some water in a tub and used a paintbrush to write numbers on the ground. You have to be quick though before they dry up and disappear!



Remember you can use your fingers to say number rhymes like this one to help you count:

1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive 6,7,8,9,10 then I let it go again

Why did you let it go? Because it bit my finger so!

Which finger did it bite? This little finger on my right!

If you really love exploring numbers and making number stories you could use sticks to make a frame. My first story is about 4. Do you know what my story is telling you? It is saying that 3 and 1 make 4 altogether! You can write it like this $3+1=4$



My 10 square is a bit wonky but you can make up smaller or bigger number stories together. Do you know what this number story is telling you?



Have fun making up your own number stories together if you are ready to do that.
