



Dear Parent/ Carer,

In Giffnock Primary we provide a range of additional musical opportunities for our pupils across the school to support and further enhance the national curriculum. We encourage all of our pupils to explore their musicality, develop new skills and foster a love of music.

If your child is currently in Primary 3 – Primary 6 they will have the opportunity to learn an instrument beginning in August 2021. They would either receive lessons within the school (Monday – Friday) or at the Saturday Music School which is held in Williamwood High School. Primary 3 and Primary 4

The children are taught once a fortnight by Mrs Carey, a member of the Primary Music Team. They learn a variety of songs and games, rhythms and pitches, as well as learning how to read music. ‘Peter and the Wolf’ is the listening unit for Primary 3 which also provides a great opportunity to learn about various instruments in the orchestra. In Primary 4 ‘The Carnival of Animals’ provides an opportunity for the children to learn about musical concepts and to extend their knowledge of instruments.

Singing games and rhymes

Our Primary 2 and 3 pupils have the opportunity to attend the Singing Games and Rhymes programme at the Saturday Music Centre at Williamwood High School. The course consists of three blocks of class and is designed to help develop a variety of skills through Kodaly based musicianship training, singing and musical games. Details of the class times and application e-forms will be sent out at the start of June.

School Choir

Prior to COVID-19 pupils from Primary 5 – Primary 7 were welcomed to join our School Choir. The choir practised on a Friday afternoon and it provided a wonderful opportunity to further develop musicality and to sing as part of a group strengthening the feeling of togetherness. The choir performed at concerts and competitions organised including the Glee Competition. Once restrictions allow we would love to restart our choir.

School Show

In previous years, on a bi-annual basis, Primary 4 – 7 all perform in our School Show and get to experience being part of a production in a real theatre. All of the children sing, dance and perform on the stage in Eastwood Theatre. For session 2021/22, if COVID-19 restrictions allow, this is something that we are excited to present to you and a wonderful opportunity for our pupils.

Nativity

Every year both the Nursery and Primary 1 -3 perform a Nativity to their parents and carers. The children sing, dance and act on stage. This is often our pupils’ first experience of performing as a group in front of a large audience and something we always look forward to. It is our hope, again if COVID-19 restrictions allow, that our Nativity would go ahead in December 2021.
