### P7 Transition Experiences: 2021-2022



#### Dear Parent/Carer.

Primary 7 is an exciting and special year for all of our children. As an important part of this, transition activities aim to smooth the journey towards high school and make the move into a secondary environment more comfortable and successful. Some of these transition activities will be personalised to the meet the needs of our children, however most of them will be accessed by all of our children. Although we plan with our Woodfarm High School colleagues we ensure that the skills and experiences are transferrable to whatever final secondary destination our children pursue.

Throughout the course of this session your child will be involved in the following events and opportunities. We remind you that further documentation will be made available from East Renfrewshire Council around December time so that all families can submit their application for Woodfarm High School should they wish to apply for a place there; regardless of address, you must apply if this is your intention. Confirmation of your child's place at Woodfarm High School is shared by East Renfrewshire Council directly with parents at a later date towards the end of session.

So far this year our children have enjoyed Woodfarm teachers delivering experiences in both PE and Music, with Urdu lessons being delivered next term. As we look forwards the following experiences are planned, however as you will appreciate these may be subject to change according to national Health & Safety guidelines in relation to Covid-19, so we will continue to keep you abreast of any changes should and when these happen.
