Please also be aware that even if you live within the Woodfarm High School catchment area you still need to complete the online application to apply for a place for your child.

If you live out with East Renfrewshire Council you will need to apply for a Placing Request for your child should you wish your child to attend Woodfarm or another East Renfrewshire secondary school.
