In 2022-23, East Renfrewshire EPS had 10.3 Educational Psychologists working across 23 Early Learning and Childcare Centres, 24 Primary Schools, 7 Secondary Schools and 1 ASN school and ELCC

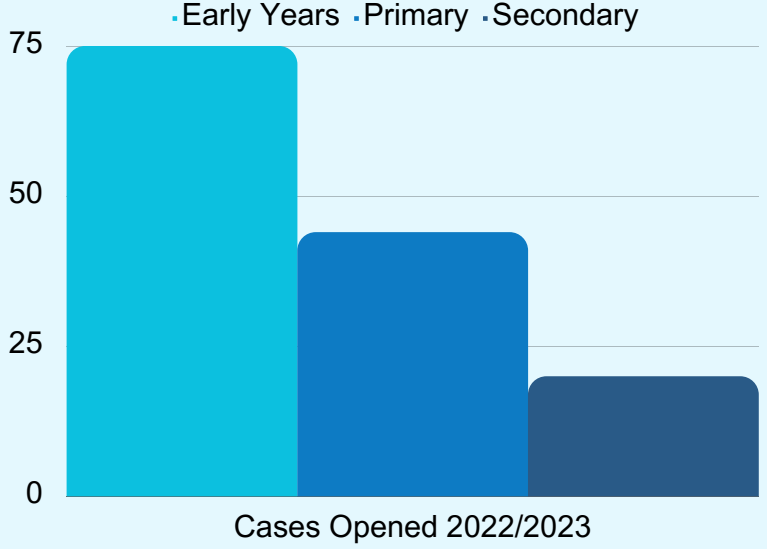
EPS currently has 867 open cases.

Total Cases Opened 2022/23: **139**

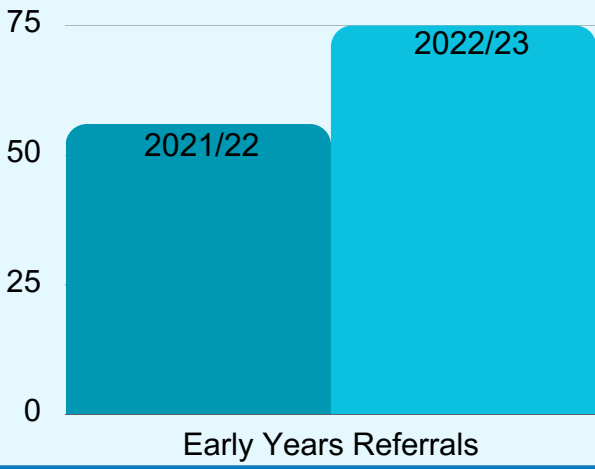
75 Early Years

Early Years Cases have increased by 34% from 2021/2022 to 2022/23.



Main Reasons for EPS Involvement

- To assess children and young people's learning needs and mental health and wellbeing
- To provide consultation to Schools and ELC and build capacity amongst staff
- To support children and young people, their families and schools through transition planning
- To put in place strategies and interventions to promote children and young people's progress and support their wellbeing

TRAINING

EPS has facilitated **31** different training inputs

This included single, multiple and ongoing inputs at an establishment, local authority and national level

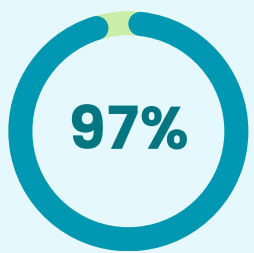
7 ELCC settings are involved, 4 have achieved validation, 2 are ready for validation. 4 settings have shown an interest in PANECAL for the next academic year
