


Sorting & Counting

Here is a simple activity you can do at home with your family.

You will need:

1. Cupcake cases
2. A pen
3. Tongs
4. For counters you can use- Pasta shapes/Pompoms/Beads etc.



Method:

1. Lay cupcake cases out on a table.
2. With help from an adult use your pen to number the cupcake cases.
3. Place your chosen counters into a bowl.
4. Use your tongs to match the correct amount of counters into the numbered case.
5. When all cases have been filled correctly you could sort the cases into the correct order.
