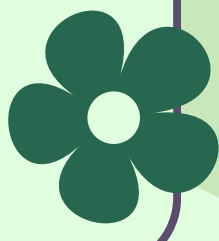
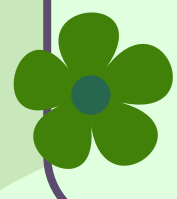
I hope this message finds you well. As we step into the vibrant month of April, we are excited for the wonderful learning opportunities and joyful experiences that lie ahead for our nursery children.

Our 4/5 year olds will begin their French Sessions after the Easter Break during their final term with us before transitioning to Primary One.

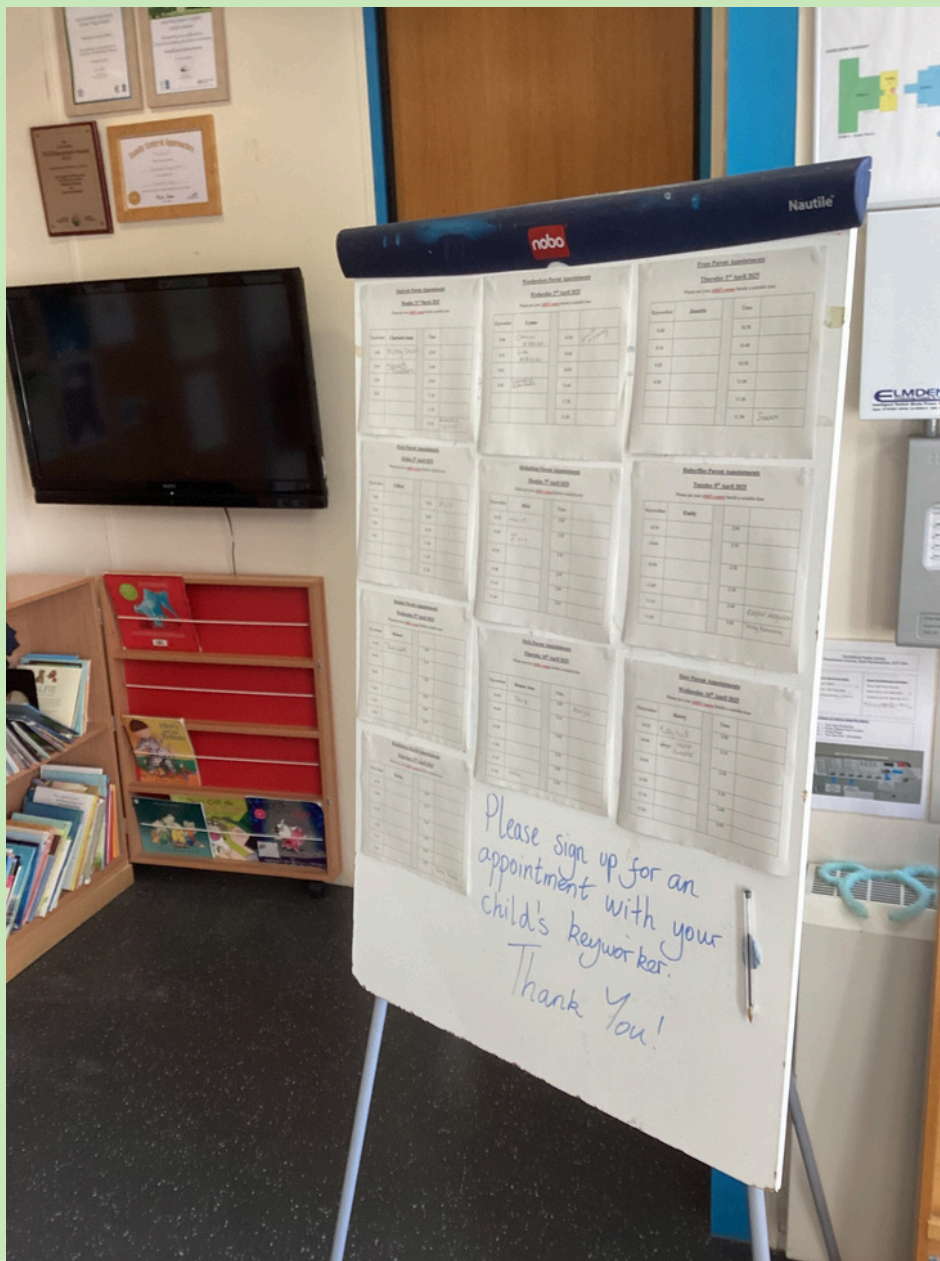


Parent Consultations

The Future of Twitter / X

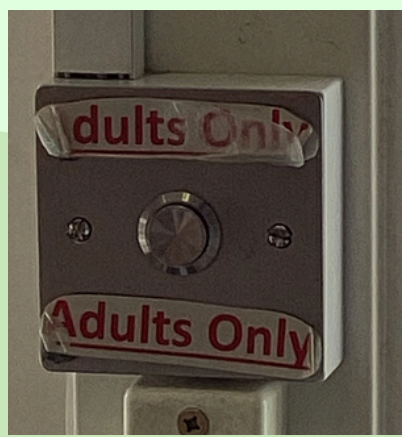
