Nurtured

For me this could be:

- Being encouraged to reach my potential
- Being praised for my hard work and effort

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils feel that teachers believe in them
- Pupils feel supported in class

Active

For me this could be:

- Being encouraged to develop my interests outside the classroom setting, e.g. S1 Stock Market Club
- The opportunity to be involved in group work, e.g. S1 Product Design and S2 Dragons Den

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils can apply knowledge gained in class in a practical manner
- Pupils develop communication and team working skills

Achieving

For me this could be:

- Receiving feedback throughout the lesson
- The opportunity to achieve a Pupil of the Month or Business Education badge

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils know how to improve and understand the next steps in their learning
- Pupils feel their hard work is recognised

Respected

For me this could be:

- Taking on a role when working in groups
- Being free to express my opinions on a range of subjects in class

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils feel empowered by being responsible for particular tasks within a group setting
- Pupils feel their opinions are listened to and valued

Healthy

For me this could be:

- Being encouraged to be resilient and embrace new challenges
- Understanding my responsibilities under the H & S at Work Act as detailed by my teachers

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are confident and competent when facing problems and new challenges in everyday life
- Pupils are given strategies for assessing and managing avoidable risk to health

Responsible

For me this could be:

- Knowing the behaviour and commitment expectations of me in the department
- Being responsible for my resources and maintaining computer safety, e.g. no eating or drinking at computers

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are responsible for their own actions and are treated as young adults
- Pupils feel trusted by staff

Safe

For me this could be:

- Awareness of procedures when moving around the classroom, e.g. pushing in chairs
- Promotion of a positive working environment where bullying is not tolerated

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are able to move around the classroom in a safe manner avoiding injury
- Pupils feel supported and can express their opinions in class

Included

For me this could be:

- Acknowledgement of my diversity and responsibility to challenge discrimination
- The positive role models my teachers provide me

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are aware of a positive attitude towards all faiths, cultures and languages
- Pupils experience positive behaviour in the classroom and wider school community
