Nurtured

For me this could be:

- Developing positive relationships with others and gaining self-assurance to develop into a confident individual
- Building confidence in my studies and developing the skills to improve my learning

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils develop problem solving skills and are taught how to apply these to personal situations
- Teachers discuss progress with pupils and set achievable targets and provide advice to assist learning

For me this could be:

- Experiencing a coherent curriculum that prepares me beyond the classroom
- The opportunity and encouragement to take part in active learning

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are given the opportunity to experience learning outside the classroom
- Pupils participate actively through debates, discussion, group work, research tasks and news quizzes

Achieving

For me this could be:

- Being given the opportunity to develop skills and gain an understanding which I can use now and in the future

Examples of this in action:

- Teachers give detailed and constructive feedback to support and help pupils in their planning and learning

Respected

For me this could be:

- Feeling that I am valued by my peers and adults and knowing the importance of respecting others

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils learn about their rights and responsibilities
- Pupils develop an understanding and respect for those of different religion, nationality and race

Healthy

For me this could be:

- Knowing where there is risk and being encouraged to make the right choices

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are aware of the impact of lifestyle choices on health and the wider impact on the well being of the community

Responsible

For me this could be:

- Feeling supported by teachers and being encouraged to take responsibility for my own learning

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are encouraged to take responsibility for their own learning and are given the opportunity to target set, plan and agree next steps, reflect and evaluate their learning

Safe

For me this could be:

- Being able to confidently approach staff with any concern and feeling safe in the History and Modern Studies department

Examples of this in action:

- Pupils are aware of departmental expectations and are supervised at all times in the classroom and the department corridor

- Receiving the support required to participate fully in class and develop my learning
