



# Parent review of Go Karting

Today we took Ruby to the Experience in Hillington. The facility feels brand new and has been going for a few months. The staff are very helpful and friendly.

We used computers to register and then selected our racing overalls, a short briefing and then out to get our helmets. All the karts are electric so the place is very quiet and has no petrol fumes.

For kids with special needs they have tandem karts which are driven by an instructor. They have ordered a kart which will take wheelchairs and a winch, but these have not arrived yet. The instructor has lots of experience with children with special needs and behavioural difficulties. Ruby took to him immediately.

They also have a lovely large cafe which will include people with special needs in the staff. It is run as a social enterprise and we were told all work and additional activities will be completed by the summer.

In the end Ruby took fright and would not get into the Kart so she watched while mum, brother and dad took turns. A family ticket is £50 which is not cheap but the whole experience was loved by us all. An individual session for someone with special needs is £10. They gave us a refund as only two of us were actually driving.
