The PODD system was designed by **Gayle Porter**, who is a Speech Therapist with over 30 years hands on experience working with people with complex communication needs. Gayle currently works at the Cerebral Palsy Education Centre in Melbourne, Australia. She also has a private practice working with both children and teenagers with complex communication needs in their schools. She has given instructional courses and papers at ISAAC's International Conference for many years, given courses all over the world and written about AAC, Cerebral Palsy and PODD.

When developing the PODD principles Gayle Porter works to support communication at any time and emphasises teaching and learning strategies to enable a person to say what they want to say, when they want to say it and to whom they want to say it to! Gayle considers it an ongoing challenge to provide sufficient vocabulary to meet both the present communication requirements and to stimulate the further development of communication and language skills


