On the Friday evening the Rett UK staff team will be in Glasgow and are happy to hold an informal meet and greet session for local families or for those who have to travel a distance and need to stay over on the Friday evening.

Depending upon demand and interest we will tailor the evening to meet the needs of the families. That could be a meeting for newly diagnosed families or to explore the possibility of starting a local support group, or just to find mutual support at the bar!

Please let us know if you going to be staying over or would like to come along on the Friday evening. We are happy to have suggestions about what would be useful to you on the Friday evening. We cannot guarantee to meet all requests but will do our best to go with the majority.

On Saturday, we will be holding an all-day event for families & professionals. There will be opportunities to hear presentations, on topics such as Music Therapy, Dental Health & Oral Hygiene, Breathing Irregularities & Sleep Issues and Transition. There will also be an update about the latest research. In addition, there will be opportunities for families to have one to one sessions with some of our experts, which includes eye-gaze technology.

There will be activities and care for people with Rett syndrome as well as their siblings if required on the Saturday. In addition, there will be a number of stalls offering useful information and advice about local services and items to purchase.

We hope that during the course of event families will have the opportunity to get together and meet with others, share experiences and contact details. Our aim is also to look at how we can provide more regular support to you if that would be helpful.

We are aware that many of you may have still have a considerable distance to travel to the event and may also require overnight accommodation.
