We will miss our friends Rob and Rebecca who are both leaving this year.

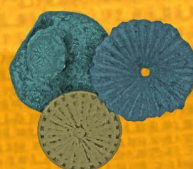

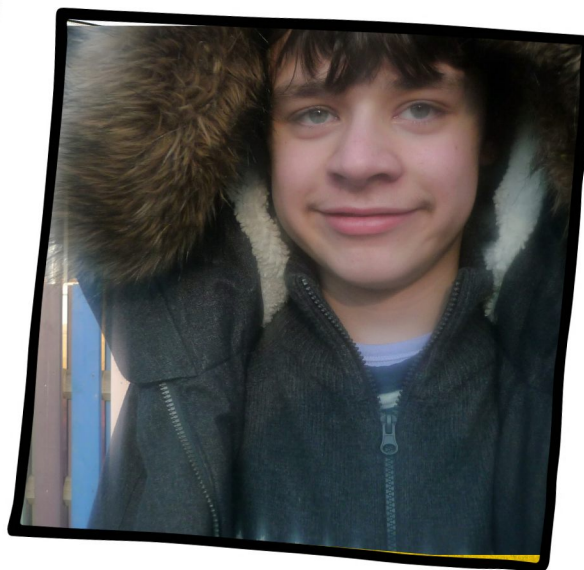

Islay

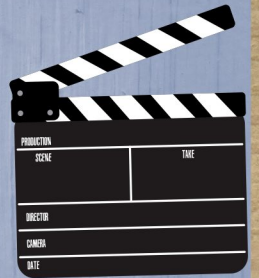

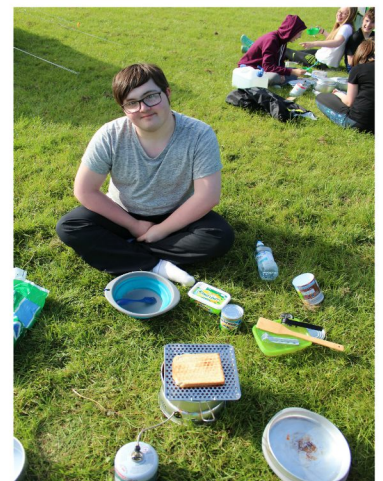


YELL FETLER UNST
