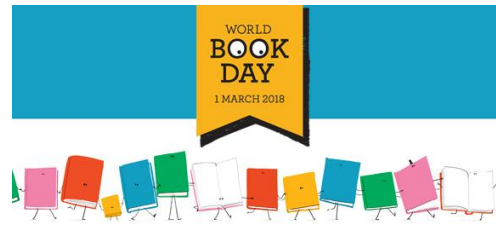


KIRKHILL PRIMARY SCHOOL

Our Librarian Pupil Group want to make our World Book Day celebrations exciting and enjoyable. They have spent the last few weeks preparing activities which will challenge our pupils and link to some of the Experiences and Outcomes within a Curriculum for Excellence.

Planned School Activities



Dress Down

On Thursday 7th March pupils may come to school in non-uniform and bring or wear a prop from their favourite book. For example glasses from Harry Potter or a cape from Captain Underpants. The pupils will get the chance to share their prop with their class and why they have chosen it.



Book Swap Bonanza

Next week we will be holding a Big Book Swap Bonanza. Pupils can bring in 1 book that they no longer need into school before Wednesday 6th March and on World Book Day will have the opportunity to swap them for other books. Only pupils that bring books will participate in the book swap and each pupil who has brought a book in will go home with another book. Please make sure that any books that are sent in are in a good condition and age appropriate for your child. Please note that the Librarian Pupil Group and Miss McCann will supervise this activity and will encourage pupils to choose very carefully!



Other planned activities include:

- Reading books for pleasure at regular intervals throughout the day
- P1 and P2 pupils will listen to stories being read to them by our Librarian Pupil Group
- Reading based activities throughout the school to develop a love for reading.
- P4-7 pupils will watch an Authors Live and take part in a linked activity.
- Creating a whole School Travelling Book



To round off the day pupils will be given a World Book Day voucher for £1 which can be redeemed at Bookshops displaying a World Book Day poster or notice. Please note that the redemption period for the World Book Day Book Token is the Thursday 28 February - Sunday 31 March 2019 and that only ONE token will be redeemed per book.
