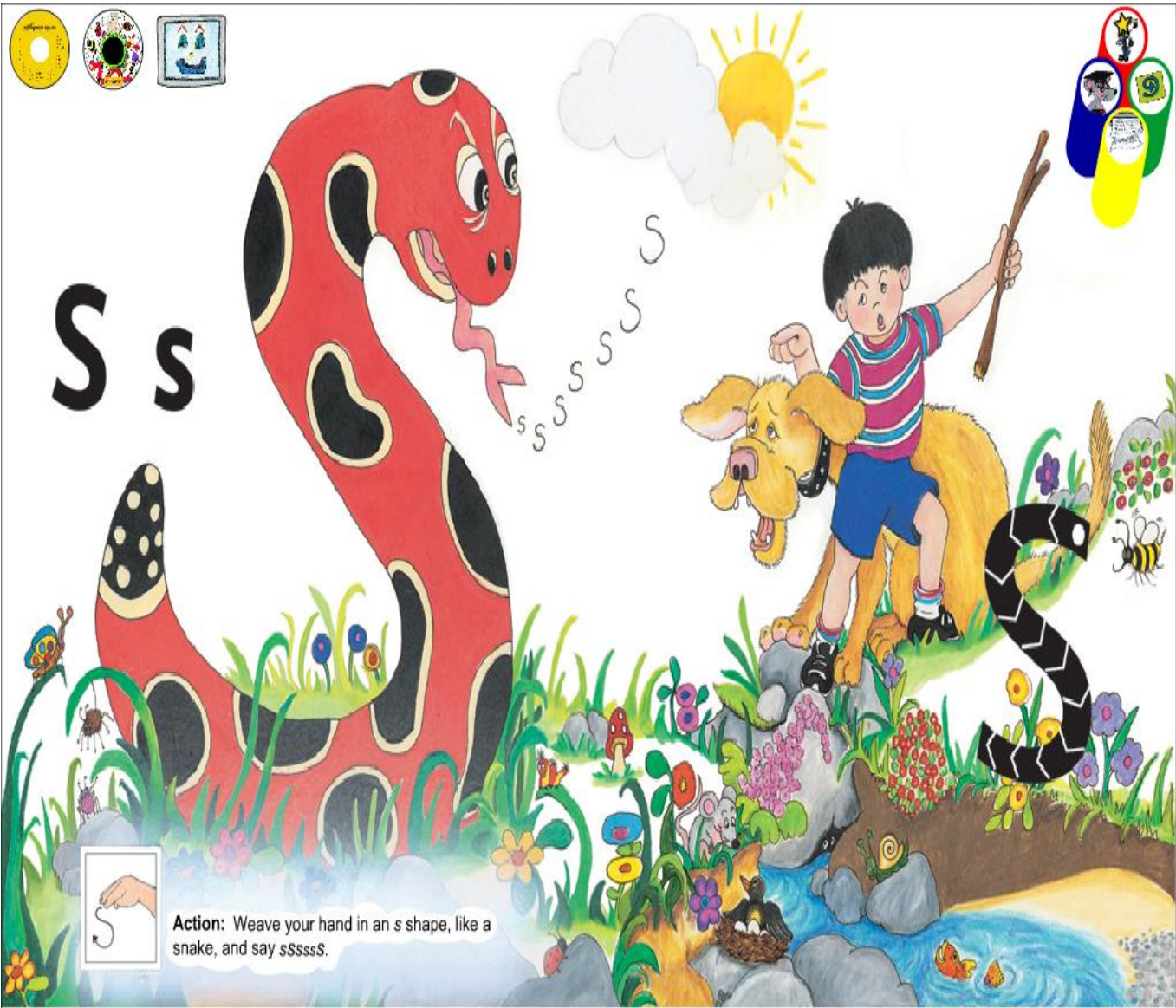

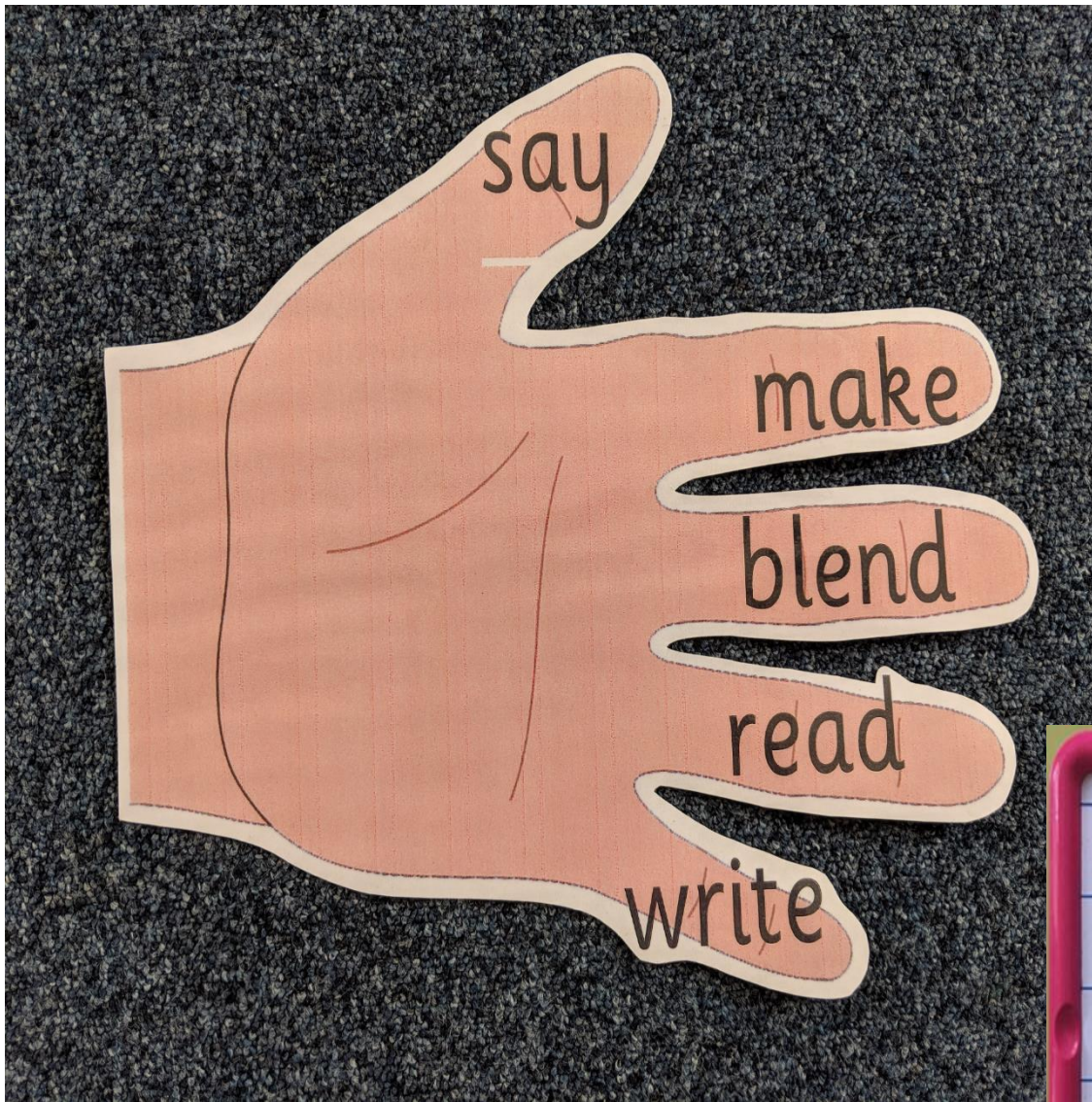

The Story of 'ch'

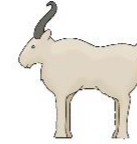

Read to the end and come back.



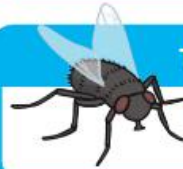

Look for chunks.



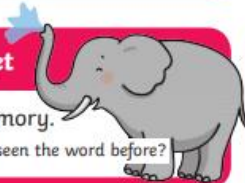
Tommy Tracker

At home...

Routine

Relaxed time

Fun

Continue to encourage and praise to help develop confidence.

Use the reading strategies to support your child's reading.

Ask questions when reading.

Play games that are sent home to reinforce reading words.

What can you do at home?



- Smooth out 'robot reading'
- Read the homework book a few times to reinforce fluency – read to a different audience 😊
- Look at the text and talk about punctuation, tricky words, high frequency words, practise reading strategies, rhyme, syllables, phonic blends
- Try not to jump in and correct too quickly
- Read all around – signs, packets, adverts, comics, leaflets

Parent activities booklet

- Booklet broken down into activities with icon to show which area is being explored
- ‘Changing words’

Shadow play

Throughout the book you can spot the cat's shadow. Can you use your hands to make a shadow on the wall that looks like an animal?



Changing words

The cat uses the words *annoying*, *strange*, *disgusting* and *stupid* at the start of the book to describe the dog. What words might the cat use at the end of the book?



Create a story

Ask your child to roll the story cubes and make up a story including one or more of the images. They could tell it to you, write it down, act it out or even film it!



Pass the story

One player starts the story by rolling one of the story cubes and making up a sentence based around the image. Each player takes it in turns to choose a story cube to roll and add a sentence to the story. The sillier the story ends up, the better!

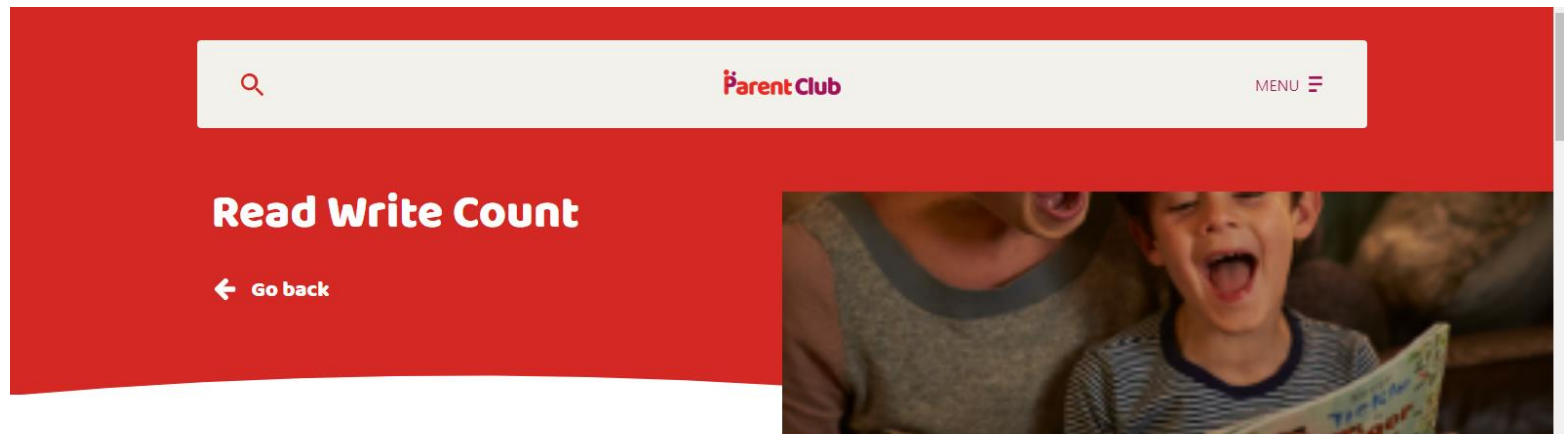

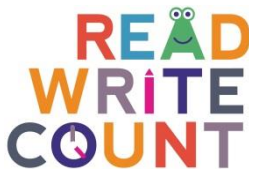

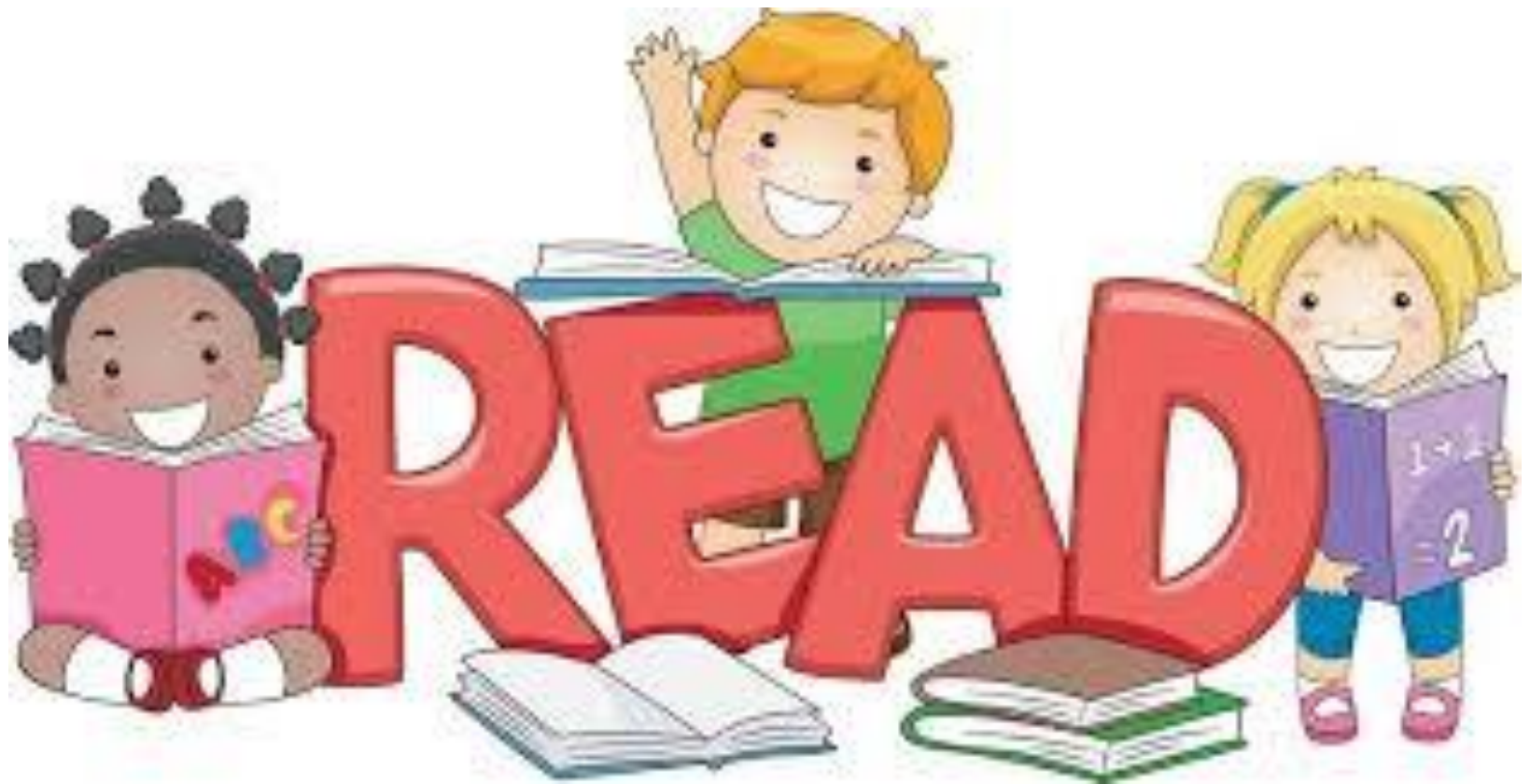
Welcome to Parent Club!
