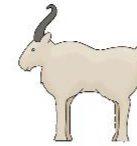
## The Story of 'ch'

## Sharp Eye

Look at the pictures.



## Hop, Skip and Jump

Read to the end and come back.



## Mouse the Mouth

Say the first sound.



## Try on the Fly!

Try a word that makes sense.



## Sound Talk It

Say each sound.



## Slide the Snake

Blend the sounds together.



## Chunky Monkey

Look for chunks.



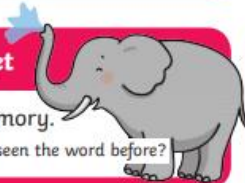
## Tommy Tracker

Point to each word as you read.



## Don't Forget

Use your memory.  
Where have you seen the word before?



## Flippy Dolphin

Flip the vowel from short to long.





At home...

Routine

Relaxed time

Fun

Continue to encourage and praise to help develop confidence.

Use the reading strategies to support your child's reading.

Ask questions when reading.

Play games that are sent home to reinforce reading words.



# What can you do at home?



- Smooth out 'robot reading'
- Read the homework book a few times to reinforce fluency – read to a different audience 😊
- Look at the text and talk about punctuation, tricky words, high frequency words, practise reading strategies, rhyme, syllables, phonic blends
- Try not to jump in and correct too quickly
- Read all around – signs, packets, adverts, comics, leaflets

# Parent activities booklet

- Booklet broken down into activities with icon to show which area is being explored



Choose one of the cards and identify the picture e.g. cat. Ask your child to think of as many different words as they can to describe the image. They could draw the image in the centre of a page in their notebook and write the words around it.



Take turns to tell a story in 30 seconds including all three images on the story cards.



How many smaller words can your child make using the letters from the Bone-Eating Snot Flower Worm? E.g. snail.

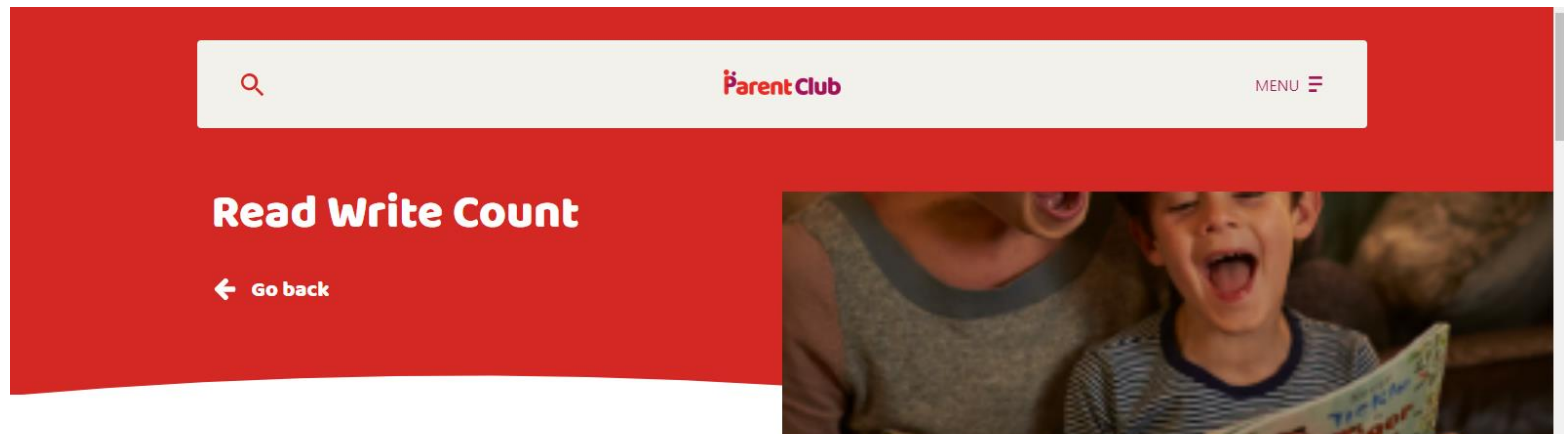

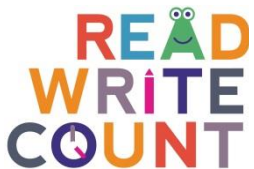
