Primary 7 Yearbook 2020

Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope to find your family safe and well during these unprecedented times. We have been really impressed with the Primary 7 pupils over the last eight weeks, taking on the responsibility of home learning and showing us yet again just how amazing they can be! The attitude of our pupils have made us all so proud to work with this year group.

We are currently putting together the 'Class of 2020' Yearbook. As in previous years, each child will have their own page in the yearbook which represents them, their thoughts and their memories. We have attached the personal page template as a Word document, as well as a task map with clear instructions on how to fill out each section on the template.

This year we will be creating an online yearbook. To help collate high quality pages for our yearbook we ask that children complete their personal page for the yearbook online and not by hand. Unfortunately, a photograph of a written piece of work will not be of the quality needed for the yearbook. We would therefore ask that children complete the task online in one of the following two ways:

Our preferred method would be for children to edit the word document template attached. They are able to type in the text boxes and put a picture into the photo box. This document can then be emailed back to the school mail and will be forwarded to the Primary 7 teachers.

If this way of working above is not possible due to software access, we will also attach the template as an activity on Seesaw from Monday 18th May. In this case, children can write over the template using either the text box function or the pen tool, and send it back to us via Seesaw. We can then take this information and input it into their personal page ourselves. We would still ask this is completed online and not printed off and written on by hand.

This yearbook task will be set on Monday 18th May and children will have two weeks to complete it. The deadline for returning the task is Friday the 29th of May. We thought it would be best to send this information out today with the Friday bundle so that, if necessary, you are able to transfer the documents to another computer or device in plenty of time.

If you have any questions or need any assistance accessing the yearbook page for your child please don't hesitate to contact us.

We would encourage your child to take their time with this task and think carefully about what they are writing. It will be an everlasting memory in the yearbook and something for them to keep forever.

We are all working hard to find new ways of ensuring our Primary 7 pupils have a special experience in their last weeks of primary school.
