And please don't forget to identify all uniform items with your child's name, or initials, and their class. With that information noted on a label any lost items have a much higher chance of finding their way back to their owner.

As we come into autumn and winter and the weather gets colder and wetter it is really important that children have the appropriate clothing to take part in all their lessons. Teachers are keen to take as many opportunities for outdoor learning as possible and we also try to ensure that pupils go outside to play during break and lunchtime, even on a drizzly day, so please ensure that a waterproof jacket is brought to school every day over the autumn and winter months.

Please remember that our uniform is an important part of our school's identity and ethos; it is simple, smart and unifies all our pupils, so to this end it is important that some items are not worn or brought to school by pupils. These include items which may encourage factions, such as football colours or items which could cause offence, such as anti-religious or political slogans.

At Kirkhill we are #Proud of our pupils and in turn their pride in their uniform and appearance help us to promote our values and rules, both within the school and beyond.
