## Help us to keep our school community safe

- Please Keep the areas around the school clear.
- Please limit to 1 adult per household at pick up and drop offs
- Move on quickly from the school gates to avoid any congestion
- Please wear face coverings at our school gates during pick ups and drop offs
- Please remember to dispose of any single use masks in a bin once you have used them

It's really important that we all take precautions to minimise the risks of spreading Covid-19 and that includes proactively making sure we aren't asymptomatic but still possibly infectious to others. The asymptomatic test centre is for anyone who doesn't have symptoms and is quick and easy with results provided within a short period of time. It's open to anyone, with no appointment necessary and can be used by anyone aged 5 or over (although under 12s need to be accompanied by an adult). The centre is based in Cowan Park in Barrhead and is open from Mon-Fri 10am – 5:15pm and Saturdays from 12-5pm. More information is available here:
