Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to you today to give you some background information on the Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood (RSHP) curriculum that is a key part of our wider Health and Wellbeing curriculum, and which all classes within the school will be working with this year. At Kirkhill we will be following the Scottish National RSHP curriculum. This was introduced a few years ago as part of a Curriculum for Excellence update and includes new resources for class teachers to use when teaching this aspect of the curriculum.

The curriculum is designed to be progressive from Primary 1 through to high school and gives pupils the age appropriate content they need to achieve each level.
