## Help us to keep our school community safe

- Please Keep the areas around the school clear.
- Please limit to 1 adult per household at pick up and drop offs
- Please wear face coverings at our school gates during pick ups and drop offs (unless exempt)
- Please continue to stay socially distant from one another and keep 2m apart from other adults and families
- Please move away from the gates and school grounds as soon as you have collected your children

It's really important that we all take precautions to minimise the risks of spreading Covid-19 and that includes proactively making sure we aren't asymptomatic but still possibly infectious to others. The Scottish Government are advising adults to take regular lateral flow tests. If you or anyone in your family tests positive on a lateral flow test it is important that everyone in your household isolates until you have received a PCR result. Test and Protect will then give you guidance on what you should do if the result is positive.

If you do have symptoms or have been asked to take a test because you're a close contact of someone who has tested positive, you should book a PCR test online and again all family members should isolate until you receive your results and further guidance from Test and Protect. If you test positive with the omicron variant you will receive further guidance informing you and close contacts to isolate for 10 days. **IF YOU ARE REPORTING THAT YOUR CHILD HAS TESTED POSITIVE PLEASE INFORM US IF THEY HAVE THE OMICRON VARIANT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.**
