


Start and End of Day Consultation

Over the past 2 years we have been using a staggered approach to start and finish times at Kirkhill to help ease numbers at the start and end of the school day. This has helped us with covid mitigations and has reduced the number of cars around the school at peak times. There has been a reduction in near misses and dangerous driving around the school as a result. The staggered start for our younger pupils means that there is no loss of learning as the pupils start earlier and finish earlier and when they come in they go straight onto learning activities.
