Dear Parents & Carers,

As I am sure most of you will be aware the Bikeability training we do with pupils in Primary 5, Primary 6 and sometimes Primary 7 is a very important part of the curriculum at school. It teaches the children a lot of skills over and above just the cycling skills needed to cycle safely on the road.

However, with a reduction to the East Renfrewshire Bikeability team and the number of trained adults available it is becoming increasingly difficult to staff these sessions so they can be done safely. By law we have to have a 1:8 ratio of trained adults to children when we are out cycling on the road.

To support us with the ongoing provision of this important training we are looking for any parents who would be willing to undergo the Cycling Scotland Bikeability training and then volunteer to support sessions at school.
