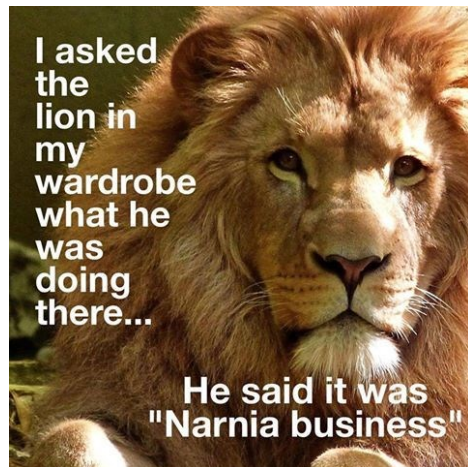

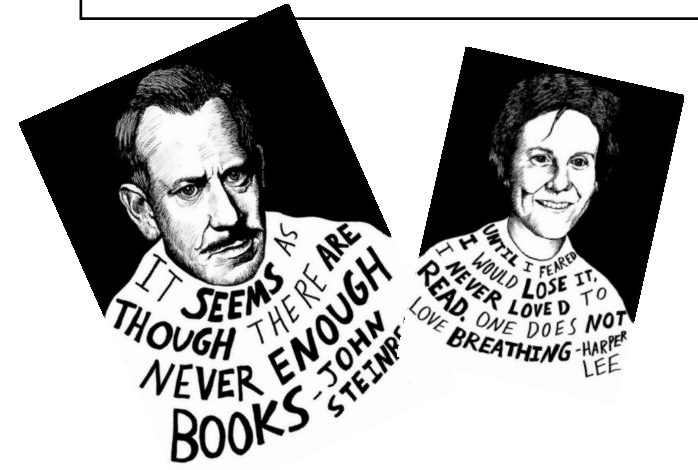

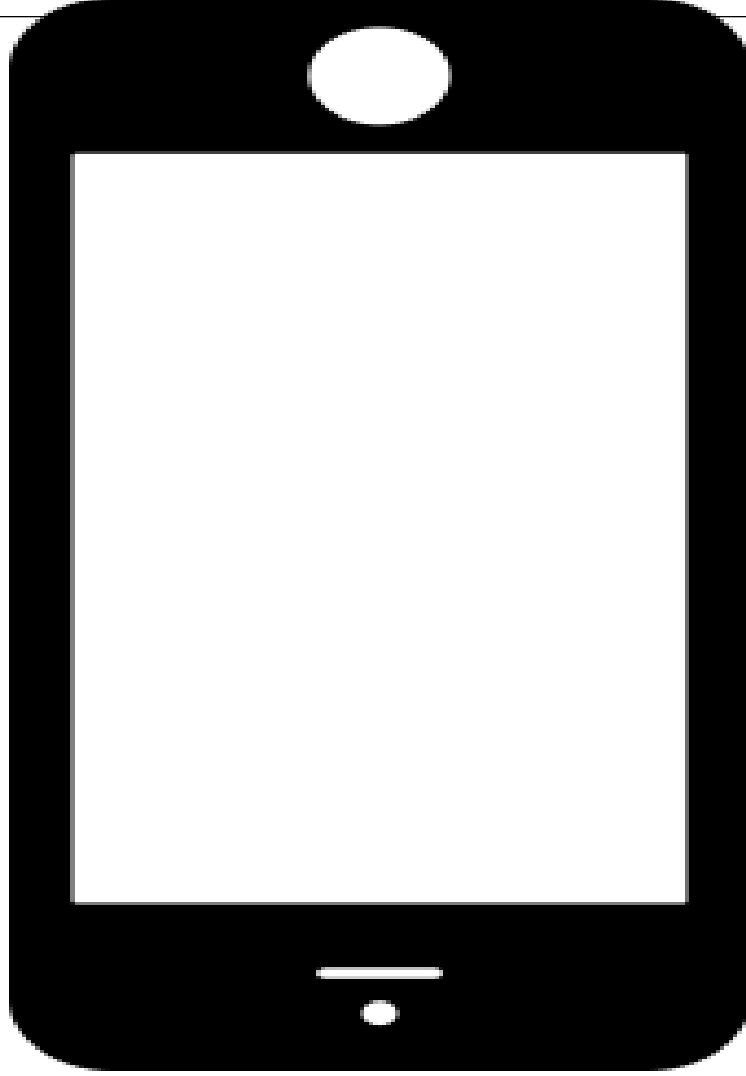
## Level Three—join a guild
