The 4 main articles chosen (see below) will now help to inform our children's charter:

Article 3 - Best interest in the child – Adults must do what is best for children

Article 12 – Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters that affect them

Article 28 – Every child has the right to an education

Article 31 – Every child has the right to relax, play and take part in a wide range of cultural and artistic activities
