Vision Values and aims will reflect our family centre community

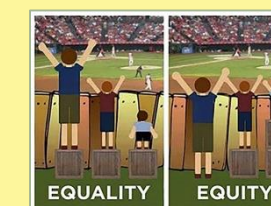
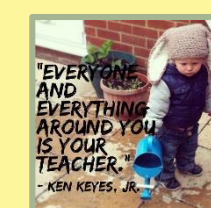


Playful Pedagogy

Environments will be designed to ensure that children with ASN are supported to make choices, follow instructions and access resources independently

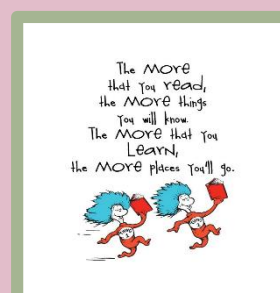
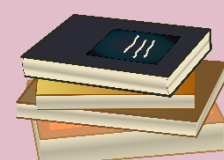
