2. Matters Arising:

- Removal of Lollipop person at junction of Old Mearns Road and Eaglesham Road – response received, as detailed under Correspondence.
- Gym Equipment – see Finance Update

3. Correspondence:

- Response on 9 November 2018 from ERC Environment Department regarding Mearns Road/Eaglesham Road junction was forwarded by email to Parent Council members. The email included information that a series of pedestrian refuge islands would be installed on Eaglesham Road. It is anticipated that the improvements will be implemented by the end of March 2019.

4. Head Teachers Report
