Frequently Asked Questions

Q – Do I need experience?

A – Yes however it can be gained through babysitting (out with family), volunteering with children e.g. Scouts, BB, clubs, childminding, sports clubs or employment.

Q – What if I have no experience?

A – You can volunteer with MACS for 3months which would be reviewed thereafter.

Q – What will my hours of work be?

A – Morning shift is 7:45 to 9am* the returning for the Afternoon shift 2:45 to 6pm, you will work Monday to Friday, term time only (off school holidays). 22.5hrs per week. * some projects are afternoon only and start/finishing times may vary.

Q – What will I get paid?

A – Starting pay £8.21 rising to £9.00 when qualified. (April2020 pay increase pending.)

Q – What will I wear?

A – Uniform provided - MACS Polo Shirt/ hoodie and you can wear casual comfy trousers and shoes.

Q – What Qualification will I gain?

A – To begin with, SQA Playwork SCQF Level6.

Q – Will I get holiday pay ?

A – Yes (including 9 Public holidays).

Q – Requirements of a Support Worker?

A – All staff must undergo Protection of Vulnerable Groups scheme checks, SSSC Registration, Reference checks and be able to provide at least 1 Childcare Reference (out with family)
