

The Aspiring Professionals Programme (APP) 2021:

We have partnered with the Social Mobility Foundation to run the **APP J.P. Morgan Digital or Banking and Finance Insight** supporting **high achieving** students from across the UK to access top universities and careers across a 5 year programme. We offer support through our four pillars:

1. **Mentoring by a professional from J.P. Morgan**
2. **Tailored skills sessions and career workshops**
3. **University application support and guidance**
4. **A 2 week internship programme with J.P. Morgan (in person in London if guidelines allow, if not this will be a virtual internship)**

Our two week virtual internship which we ran this summer was made up of webinar overviews covering different aspects of J.P. Morgan featuring speakers from across the firm, video calls with professionals from 12 lines of business, student project work where participants were able to network with fellow students from across the UK, and students had 2 video calls with their dedicated J.P. Morgan mentor.

Eligibility Criteria

- Currently in S5 (Scotland) and have at least 5 National 5s at A/B and be on track to achieve ABBB at Higher or equivalent or 5 National 5s at A/B having attended a school with a 50% or lower National 5 pass rate.
- Students must be **personally eligible** for Free School Meals (FSM) at any point since the start of secondary school, but do not need to have claimed them OR **first generation** of their family to attend university and attend a school with a higher than average number of students eligible for Free School Meals. Please note, we welcome applications from students in London but these students cannot apply directly to our J.P. Morgan Insight strand, please apply for our APP City Programme and select either our Digital or Banking and Finance strand.

Care-Experienced Offer

We also have an 'academic requirements only' offer for students who are **care-experienced**; they should have **5 A*/C (9-4) grades at GCSE or equivalent, and be predicted BBC at A Level or equivalent.**
