These clubs run in addition to the schools current programme of activities.

To apply for a club please fill out the form overleaf and return it to the SCHOOL OFFICE in an envelope marked with child's name as soon as possible. To help supplement the cost of running these clubs a small charge is associated with some of the clubs, please see overleaf for information. Clubs are to be paid for using parent pay. Clubs places will be confirmed by text. We do not discriminate access to clubs based on financial hardship, if this applies to you please contact the school office as your child may be entitled to reduced costs. Please ensure that you collect your child from the gym doors at the end of the session. If your child cannot attend the session one week please inform the school prior to 3pm.
