  SHANARRI wellbeing indicators.
- Continue to develop stronger links with the local community including the voluntary sector, intergenerational organisations, local businesses and partners in order to enhance Community Learning, the school and nursery's place in the community and also our children's sense of identity within the Netherlee Community.
