Scarecrows Galore



To coincide with Scarecrow Trail '20 in the Netherlee and Stamperland area the children will be learning about why farmers put scarecrows in their fields. Our Literacy focus will come from Julia Donaldson's well known book 'The Scarecrow's Wedding'. The book provides plenty of opportunities for listening for rhyming words as well as providing a stimulus for discussion and possible questions we could ask the characters in the story. I'm sure we'll be singing 'I'm a Dingle, Dangle Scarecrow' too!

The Numeracy focus will come from Harry's need for 'a jug or a vase or a cup or a tin' to carry the water. The children will be asked to think of other items than can be used to carry water, as well as being asked to estimate, compare and measure the capacity. Artwork may be inspired from photographs or research on our new ipads of different scarecrows. Some children may even decide to design wedding clothes for a scarecrow, or clothes for another special occasion.

The children in each zone will also be involved in the creation of a scarecrow to be part of the trail from w/c 28th September. Look out for our three scarecrows!
