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Dear P7 Parents/ Carers

As you are aware next week is our 'Alternate P7 activity Week'. This obviously involves the children taking part in a range of activities both around the school and in Linn Park. I thought I would share the range of activities with you just now so you have a rough idea of what is happening and to prepare you for how (the state that) the children may return home each day ☺ and also a reminder that children should bring a packed lunch, a couple of snacks and a refillable water bottle for each day's endeavours.

We will be using Linn Park for a lot of our activities but will all regroup together on the pitch at school every lunchtime.

Now to the activities, there will be 4 activities over the Monday and Tuesday morning and 4 different activities on Wednesday and Thursday morning. Afternoons are for larger group activities and will be mostly around the school grounds.

**Monday and Tuesday morning** – Insect Bridge Building Challenge, Nature Art, Den Building and Building Bird Boxes

**Afternoon** – Capture the Flag and Blind Man's Run

**Wednesday and Thursday morning** – Orienteering, Hammock Building, Linn Park Quest, Nature Modelling

**Afternoon** – Park Walk and Tyre game/ Mixed Sports

**Friday morning** – Time Capsule Event

**Friday afternoon** – Fire pits/ Smores and Storytelling

Hopefully this will give you a flavour of the week ahead. The children should just come into school as normal each day so we can take registers and then we will assemble on the pitch to get into groups and start that day's activities.
