Following the great success and enthusiasm shown for our Book Sales in previous years, we are pleased to let you know that we are planning to hold a Book Sale once again in school, between the 22nd and 26<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

Our Book Sale will require to run slightly differently this year, as unfortunately parents are still unable to come into school. During the week, pupils will have an opportunity to visit our Book Sale with their class to browse the books that are available. The children will then be given a wish list slip detailing the title(s) and the cost of the book(s) that they would like. Your child will then bring this slip home for you to decide which, if any, books you would like to purchase.

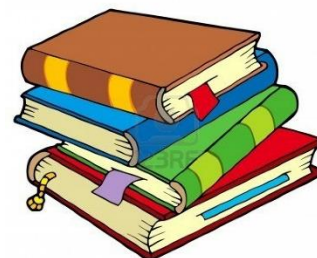
There is absolutely no obligation for an order to be placed however, if you would like the book(s) to be ordered for your child, we ask parents to login to ParentPay to make payment through the Book Sale item which will be set with a maximum limit of £20. We also ask that your child returns their wish list slip, ticked with the book(s) you have ordered and paid for 3<sup>rd</sup> December. Please note that we will only order books once payment has been received via ParentPay and therefore the decision to purchase any books is entirely optional.

Prices of books on offer range from £2.99 to £12.99 and information about some of the books that will be available is provided in the accompanying leaflet, although a much greater variety will be available for your children to view/ browse in school.

We would like to thank you for your continued support with our Book Sales. We believe that they are an exciting and engaging way to promote reading for our children. In addition, any profits made by the school will be used, as they have in the past, to enhance the range of literacy resources and variety of texts that are available for our children in school.
