<p>Make sure others who want to join in with games and activities have the opportunity to do so</p> <p>Have access to safe and quiet areas if you choose</p>	<p>You have the right to be protected from being hurt and mistreated, in body or mind. <b>Article 19</b></p>	<p>Supervise play and keep children safe</p> <p>Support pupils to interact with their peers</p>
<p>Try to sort out your own disagreements as far as possible but seek peer mediation or an adult's advice when necessary</p>	<p>Your school should help you use and develop your talents and abilities. It should also help you learn to live peacefully, protect the environment and respect other people. <b>Article 29</b></p>	<p>Listen to pupils and support them in resolving disputes when necessary</p>
<p>Look after equipment, share with others and tidy it away at the end of your game</p> <p>Follow the rules about entering the school building</p>	<p>You have the right to play and rest. <b>Article 31</b></p>	<p>Give fair and equitable access to equipment and specialised playground areas</p> <p>Monitor any equipment so that is safe to use</p> <p>Help pupils to look after and put away equipment</p>
<p>Eat small snacks only when outside</p> <p>Put litter in the bin</p>		<p>Monitor litter in the playground and encourage pupils to use the bins available</p>
