<p>Follow the law on passenger safety</p> <p>Stay in your seat and do not move about the bus</p> <p>Wear seatbelts at all times and do not remove them until the bus stops at your bus stop</p>	<p>You have the right to be protected from being hurt and mistreated, in body or mind. Article 19</p> <p>Your school should help you use and develop your talents and abilities. It should also help you learn to live peacefully, protect the environment and respect other people. Article 29</p>	<p>Supervise play and keep children safe and follow the Highway Code</p> <p>Support pupils to put on their seatbelts</p>
<p>Talk quietly to your friends and do not distract the driver or other children with loud noise</p> <p>Be allowed to sit quietly if you choose</p> <p>Try to sort out your own disagreements as far as possible but seek peer mediation or an adult's advice when necessary</p>	<p>You have the right to play and rest. Article 31</p>	<p>Listen to pupils and support them in resolving disputes when necessary</p>
<p>Keep the bus clean and tidy for all users</p> <p>Do not eat or drink on the bus Tidy away any litter</p> <p>Wipe shoes before entering the bus where possible</p>		<p>Give fair and equitable access</p> <p>Monitor facilities so that the bus is safe and tidy</p> <p>Help pupils to look after the bus</p>
